God's Grace, strength, and provision are evident because of you upholding us in prayer. The Lord miraculously provided to purchase the needed equipment to put KIBC on low power. We thought we could order an antenna and cables and be able to be back on the air. But items were back ordered and it took over six weeks to build the antenna. We are reminded that God says in Isaiah 55:8-9 *For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.*

Many of you know that on Sunday morning, December 30th, 2012, we found Sharon Rose, our little seven year old, unresponsive having seizure like attacks. We took her down to Mercy Medical Center in Redding. By January 1 her condition was even worse and the decision was made to fly her to UC Davis Medical Center. The MRI and second lumbar puncture were positive for viral meningeal encephalitis. She was in the hospital for eighteen days. The Lord answered her prayer that she would be home for her birthday.

The day we brought her home we received the last of the radio parts to be able to go on low power. God's timing is perfect. He knows the beginning and the end. Even though the radio was off the air, God knew we needed time to go back and forth between home and Sacramento.

Back in December, Richie Hathaway helped us put up a temporary pole for our antennas. We are so thankful for his time and equipment. After we completed that part, the snow came. It dumped about six feet of snow at our transmitter site. Our brother, Phil Vander Werf from Michigan, had come for a visit and was able to help place the antennas to get us back on the air. Again the timing was providential. *"When we walk with the Lord in the light of His Word, what a glory He sheds on our way. While we do His good will, He abides with us still and with all who will trust and obey."*

We are currently broadcasting on only 700 watts. We would love to hear from you to know the extent of KIBC's signal. The next phase of the project is to order a new tower. It will be twice as high as the temporary pole. We will have to wait for some of the snow to melt before doing the construction but again God's timing is perfect. We look forward to the day when we can be back to full power, 3000 watts. Thank you for all of your prayers for KIBC and for our little Sharon Rose. We have a great God that not only hears our prayers but delights to do the miraculous.
